#### √ Obtain a login

Visit https://access.teachers.ab.ca and click on "Request an account" (You must have a teaching certificate number to register).

#### ✓ Update your online member profile

Once you log in to your ATA Online account, go to "Your Account" at the top of the screen and click on "Profile Update".

## √ Sign up for (and read!) email updates

Email updates are sent whenever there is new bargaining information available. You will need to log in to your ATA Online account to view the update. Make sure you register using a non-school email!

The ATA News is published bi-weekly. Watch for multiple articles of interest as Collective Bargaining progresses.

WE Day is an annual "youth empowerment" event organized by WE Charity, which is part of the Free the Children Charity.
