- Kindergarten is back on the radar
- May see in the next while are “like minded” people. We agree on the key elements of education and rumour has it that the PC budget was in way bigger trouble than they were telling us so the NDP government has a bigger problem than we knew about. So budget problems are still possible.

- Budget needs to be transparent so people know what they are voting for. It needs to be simplified. We want a second sober thought.
- Kelly - ARA; can expenses be reimbursed for certain things that Rhonda Smith did not have receipts for. **Kelly motioned that we pay Rhonda Smith \$200 to help her get back some of the money she spent. John Warenycia seconded this motion.**
  - Discussion: Her claims came in at less than \$400.00 and usually it is about a \$1100 claim.
  - Everybody is entitled mileage and hotel through ATA. If we are putting money forward it should be put into one of those categories. If ARA delegates want to spend money to enjoy themselves it should come out of their pocket.
  - This is a comprehensive allowance and could have been paid to her in full before she left.
  - Her expenses are legitimate, they are not claimed. Knowing this, can we fit them into any of the lines we have in existence?
  - She is not comfortable with claiming the whole amount because she did not spend it.
  - This is a way to honor what people are doing.
